10. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECKING

- 10.1 Administrative checking will be held in the paddock Circuit Słomczyn at main building.
10.2 The check shall consist of an inspection of the documents, International Licence, ASN's authorization where necessary, etc.

11. SCRUTINEERING

11.3 Noise: For all cars, a limit of 100 dB is imposed.

V. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

14. QUALIFYING

There will be 4 laps in the qualifying Heats.

15. FINALS

There will be 6 laps in the Finals.

16. GENERAL

16.6 Flag signals

If a black flag is shown in a heat, the driver has to go immediately to the paddock and in a final, he has to go to the Parc Fermé.

VI. PARC FERME - RESULTS – PROTESTS

20. PROTESTS – APPEALS

20.1 All protests will be lodged in accordance with the International Sporting Code.

All protests must be made in writing and handed to the Clerk of the Course or his assistant, or in their absence any of the stewards of the meeting, together with the sum of 500 €. If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of a car, the claimant must make a deposit up to 6 300 €.

20.5 Competitors have the right to appeal, as laid down in Article 181, 182 and 183 of the Code and also as set out in the rules of International Court of Appeal.

The amount of the appeal fee is 1000 €.

VII. PRIZES AND CUPS

21. PRIZES

The podium ceremony on the circuit will be held immediately after the races. The winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes must be present, wearing their race overalls. Failure to attend this ceremony and/or the wearing of inappropriate clothing will be penalized by the loss of any monetary awards/benefit associated with the corresponding position at the end of the race.

The unofficial prize-giving will be held directly after the finals on the stage on the track next to the Grand Stand.

The official prize-giving will take place on Sunday at 18h00 at the Stage

Prizes will be awarded in Euros.

22. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Each driver is responsible for ensuring that a single piece extinguisher of mi. 5 kg. (min) is available within his own team's area inside the paddock.

23. ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION

Each driver is requested to ensure that a plastic sheet (minimum dimensions 4 metres by 5) is spread on the ground in the place reserved for his team where work is to be done on his car, in order to prevent any pollution in case of an accidental leak, etc.

24. DRIVERS' LIAISON OFFICER

The Drivers' Liaison Officer will be recognisable by special clothes. The Driver's Liaison Officer will present a shedule of his duties, which shall also be posted on the Official Notice Board of the event.

7. Procedure in the event of an Accident

Minor Incident

Serious Crash

Yellow flags, report to safety officer - red flag (stop race), rescue crew, ambulance with doctor.

Maybe Fast First Aid car, move away car

Serious Crash involving Spectators

Yellow flags, report to safety officer - red flag (stop race), all rescue crews, ambulance with doctor and Fast First Aid car. In the case really serious accident the following step will be summoning of another human rescues (ambulance with doctors, air rescue service, firemen, rescue unit from the nearest hospital etc.)

Guidance for the Use of the Red Flag

Red flag can be used only Clerk of the Course and his assistant, immediately follow-up marshals on the all marshals post.

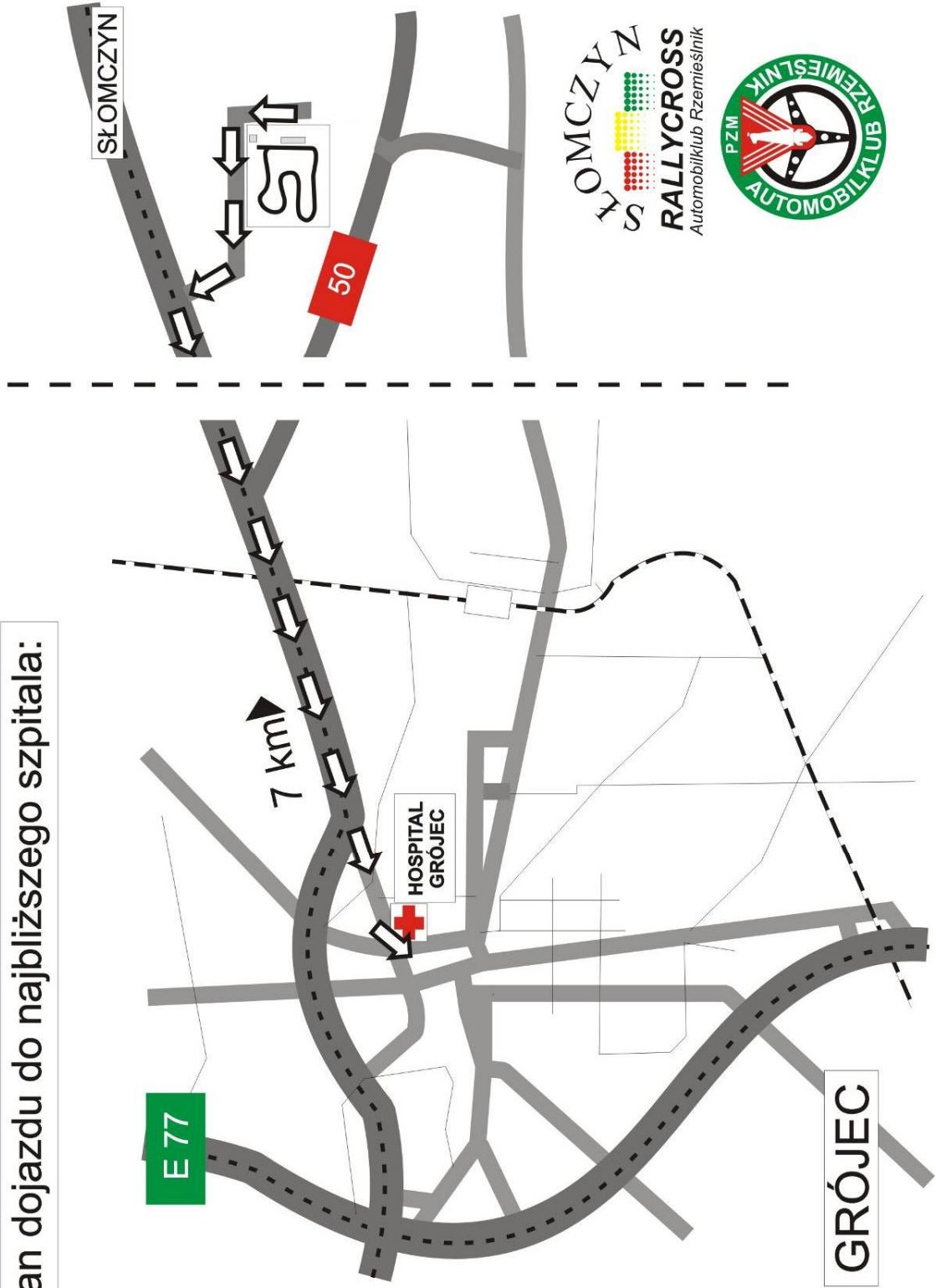

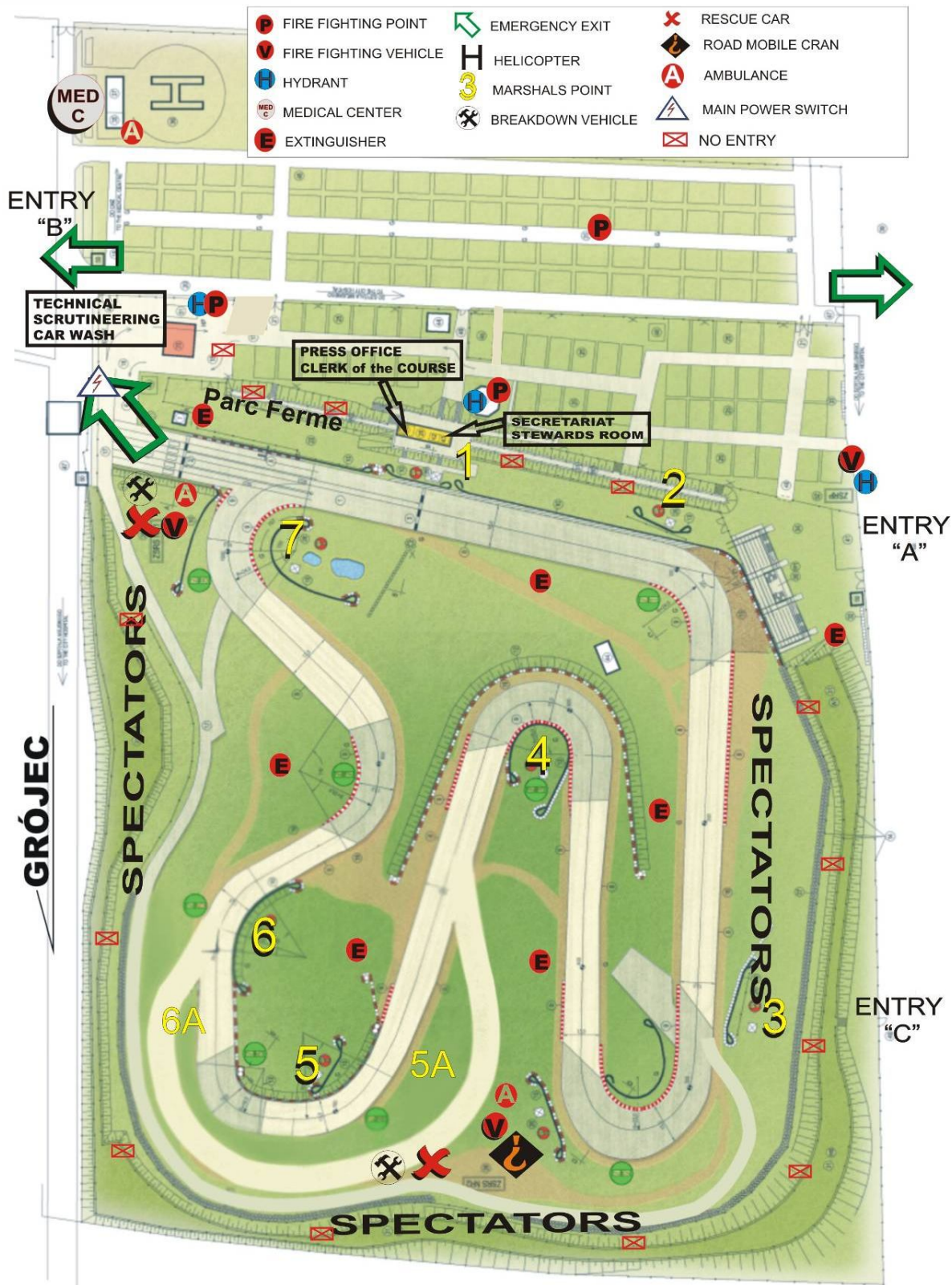
Information desk for spectators in the Paddock

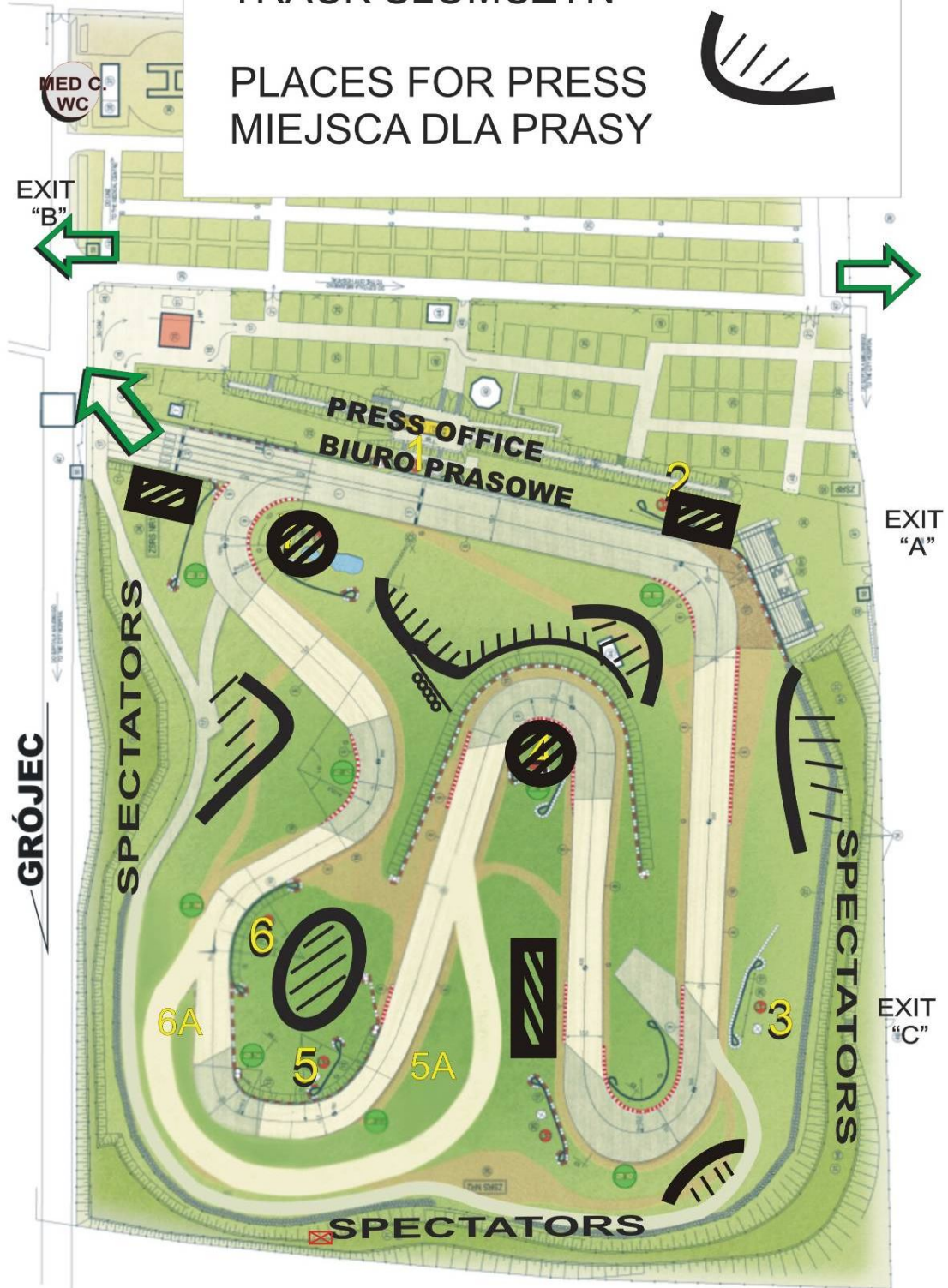
